Edkaagmik Nbiizh Neyaashiinigamiingninwag Edbendaagzijig Trust (ENNET) sets out to support the brilliance and ingenuity of our community members, no matter their location.

We are pleased to inform you that applications for 2022 are now open. We **invite and encourage you to share your creativity, answers, and approaches** to planning for now and the future for yourself and the community.

2022 applications are open for three cycles:

- 1) June 1st, 2022
- 2) June 2nd thru to July 25, 2022
- 3) July 26, 2022, thru to September 30, 2022

As trustees, we are purposeful in our planning and seek ways to align with the Community Comprehensive Plan. We know that the funds do not meet all members' requirements or ideas. Still, we do our best to support as many applications as possible for all members no matter their location while maintaining accountability and feasibility for the community to the Trust. Careful considerations are made to those applications that share how the idea/project fits the community's current needs. Trustees work with inclusivity, calm, and a respectful tone that focuses on the mindfulness of our responsibility to the community as trustees. We practice at each step of the process.

We wish to support as many ideas/projects as possible. We ask applicants to reflect on our customary way of living off the land, "using the resources provided, taking what you need, ensuring resources are left for those who follow you." We are asking you to use this way of thinking in your application.

We do not expect a 10-page document in this process. However, we ask you to please answer the following questions in the most meaningful way for you. A verbal application can be arranged in the spirit of our oral traditions.

Please use these questions as a guideline. If you need, book a time to call (see the end of the document for contact information) if you wish to make a verbal application in Ojibway or English.



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We are aware writing an application can be stressful and that applicants may write in a way to get a "yes." We wish for you to understand that is not the intention of the Trust. We humbly honor each application, and the time you will take to share your ideas and goals.

Let's begin!

Idea/Project Information:

1. We invite you to describe your idea/project (maximum 700 words. Attach separately). This question aims to ask you to share your story, your approach, and your path. (Here are examples of what could be included in your description, but not limited to the following: What is the idea/project, share why it is needed, will others benefit, where will the initiative/project take place, when do you expect it to happen, will you be partnering with any other organizations and have you reached out to any other organizations for additional financial support?)

2. Now, thinking of the time, can you share how your idea/project could or will seed a more extended-term outcome or benefit to the community and your timeline (maximum 500 words. Attach separately).

Provide intended start date: and end date:

- **3.** We hear the word "outcome and impact" often, and we understand it can mean many things. We invite you here to expand on Q.1 and consider what the intention of the project outcomes, goals or benefits of the work undertaken could or plan to be and how you will share them.
- **4.** Can you please share the primary area/s of your idea/project? (Example: culture, education, health, etc.)
- **5.** Thinking of the budget for your idea/project, please use the following template to share how resources will support reaching the goals described in questions 1 to 3.



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When filling this out, please think about how the budget relates to the work you will be doing. For example: what is the initiative's duration, how are you going to use the funds, what do you need to purchase, and are you paying people (example: salaries or honorariums).
