12:13pm- Discussing 2nd agenda item; setting date and time for AGM 2024, Paul and fellow trustees agree setting the date earlier in the year will allow members additional time to work through their applications. It was decided by all trustees that Tuesday May 14, 2024, would be this year's AGM.
